

OSF is currently researching the history of the Oceania Open Championships.

The Federation encourages Member Countries to conduct open tournaments as a means of promoting the sport in their country and attracting players from other countries.

Member Countries and Event Promoters are invited to utilise the naming rights to host the Oceania Open elevating the status and potentially attracting greater sponsorship of their event.

Member Countries are encouraged to register their event as a Challenger Tour with the PSA (Professional Squash Association) to attract a higher standard of player. The Challenger Tour provides a platform for the world's most exciting up-and-coming players to cut their teeth on the professional circuit and provides outstanding experience and competition for the host's talented players.



The Oceania Open has not been held for some years but it is hoped will be reintroduced in 2021 with Squash Australia hosting the event. More information will be provided at a later date.
